

## ***THEN AND NOW* of the Lincoln Heights Tutorial Program**

**25** years ago, the Lincoln Heights Tutorial Program (LHTP) began with just two classrooms serving 16 students (K-8<sup>th</sup> grades) in the Lincoln Heights community. Dennis Ortega, the founder of LHTP, saw a need in Lincoln Heights, an inner-city community in Los Angeles, to steer the youth away from the gang life by providing opportunities to engage in positive activities and programs. Over the years, LHTP programs have been and continue to be an integral part of the transformation process of the lives of its children and youth as well as the community as a whole. Since 1985, LHTP continues to promote and empower urban children and youth to become positive community role models. Our programs and services are deeply rooted in the development of leadership skills for our teens, promote and provide activities for college preparation and enrollment, and build a foundation that foster values such as giving back to the community. LHTP engages and teaches the youth to give back through community service, such as tutoring and providing homework assistance to children and youth in grades K-9<sup>th</sup>.

Throughout the years, LHTP has expanded its programs and services and now operates five tutoring sites, two youth clubs, one "Increase the Peace" youth advocacy planning committee, and three high school academic clubs serving over 675 students in grades K-12<sup>th</sup> in the Lincoln Heights, Boyle Heights, Chinatown, and El Sereno communities.

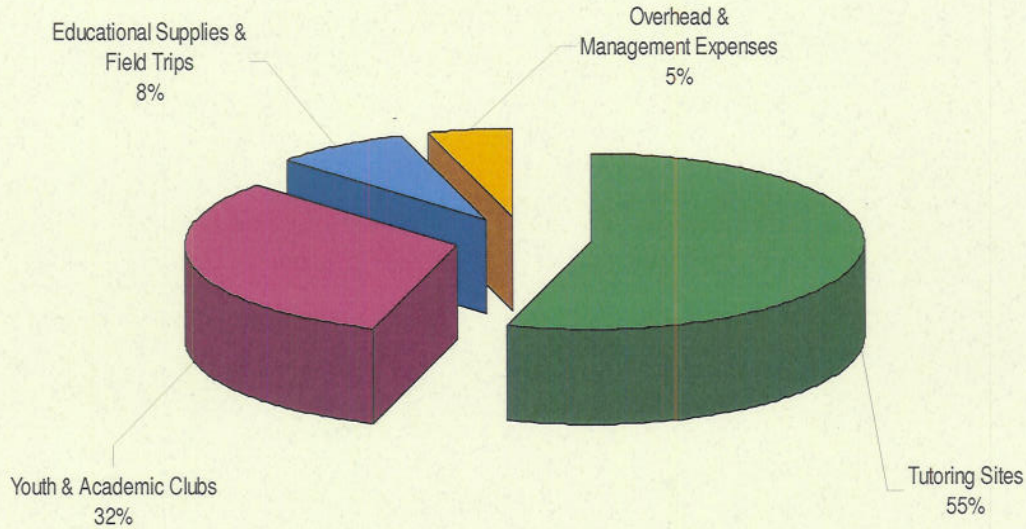
TUTORING SITES: The tutors at our five sites provide lessons in computer literacy and homework assistance in the areas of math, reading, writing, and science. Classes are by fixed enrollment, with most classes consisting of eight students with two tutors. Additionally, our tutorial program provides various educational and recreational field trips, such as trips to the California Science Center, the Natural History Museum of Los Angeles, and the Santa Fe Dam which allows the youth to enjoy, explore and experience what they learned in the classroom.

YOUTH CLUBS: The Junior Youth Club (JYC) and Youth United for Community Action (YUCA c/o LHTP) develop and nurture youth through mentorship and provide college tours, community service projects, advocacy events, social activities, inter-agency events, and leadership development and training. Members of our youth clubs are encouraged and given opportunities to care for their own community and care for one another. Each of our youth clubs also have leadership teams that are elected for one year terms by its members to facilitate events and plan for the calendar year. Members from our youth clubs are also candidates for staff positions at our tutorial sites, offices, and computer labs in Lincoln Heights and Chinatown. Adult staff advisors train and work in partnership with all our youth clubs and their leadership teams.

ACADEMIC CLUBS: LHTP supports three competitive academic clubs at Lincoln High School: the Academic Decathlon, Math Engineering Science Achievement Program (M.E.S.A.), and the Science Bowl Club. Due to limited funding from the high school, LHTP collaborates with the programs' academic coaches to provide funding for the students' competition costs.
